Minutes of the meeting of Banwy Community Council held on Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> March 2019 in Banwy Community Centre

**Declaration of Interest (002)** – Nil

**Resignations (003)** – The Clerk advised that she had received two letters of resignation, with immediate effect and had notified Powys County Council. Members of the Council instructed the Clerk to write two polite letters of thanks to both Councillors.

**Minutes of previous meeting (004)** – The Clerk was asked to make a slight amendment to the minutes, the Council were all in favour and these would be signed at April's meeting.

**Matters Arising (005)**–

**Foel Bus Shelter (012)** –

Cllr. Williams had obtained a quote for the labour and materials to fix the floor in Foel Bus Shelter. All were in favour to accept the quote of £250 for labour and a maximum of £85.28 for materials. Cllr. D. Williams would arrange.

**Highways and Footpaths (013) –**

The Clerk was asked to create flyers with regards to dog mess and Cllr. Jenkinson agreed to distribute them.

**Planning (014) -**

19/0153/FUL – Change of use of land to site 6 holiday cabins and all associated works

The Council supported this application with concerns raised on the following –

- The height of the log cabins. The Council felt that 2 storey cabins would have too much of an impact of neighbours and felt that single story would be more accommodating.
- The splay on the entrance must be widened for other road user's safety.
- The application must meet all highways and drainage needs.

19/0091/HH – Erection of replacement porch/sunroom

The Council fully supported this application with no objections.
