**Welcome to New Councillor** – The Chairman formally welcomed Cllr. Richard Jones, who also signed the declaration of acceptance of office.

**Matters Arising** –

Bus Shelter – Cllr. Jenkinson had spoken to Mike Perkins, who said he would complete the work but hadn't supplied a quote yet. Cllr. Jenkinson was asked to chase the matter and the Clerk would put this as an agenda item for December.

BARN – The Council advised that fibre is available to properties in the area and did not see the need to follow up this scheme.

School Review – The Clerk advised that she had sent the letter on the Council's behalf.

**Correspondence Received-**

The Council had received a letter from PCC which invited expressions of interest for the Healthy, Active and Outdoors project. The Council agreed to write a letter expressing their interest.

**Canolfan y Banw** – The Council agreed to invite members of the hall committee to attend the next meeting, to discuss finances and potential projects.

**Highways & Footpaths** – Cllr. Jenkinson had received a complaint regarding footpath 52. The Council advised that she should ask the resident to contact Mark Chapman at PCC.

A blocked culvert, which has been reported to PCC on numerous occasions still hasn't been cleared. The Clerk was asked to forward this to Cllr. M. Alexander.
